## Registration

Summer Programs are open to all children of the SHES community and will be held at the school. Please select the camp(s) in which your child(children) would like to enroll. A **non-refundable deposit** of \$50.00 is required to secure a place for your child in the program. Tuition should be paid in full by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Please make checks payable to: Sacred Heart Elementary School (SHES). There will be no refunds after the first day of camp and **all camp tuition must be paid in full before your child can participate**. You will receive confirmation of registration and instructions for your child's program upon receipt. Your registration will be returned to you if camp is full. We request that you fill out a separate registration for each child entering camp. It makes it easier for us to organize the paperwork.
